4.2.1.5 Persons Aged 62 or Over

The Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia provides for the admission and registration of persons 62 years of age or older. Individuals in this category are eligible to register for classes on a space-available basis without payment of tuition and mandatory fees.

- Meet all University System of Georgia (USG) and VSU admission requirements, including application fees, if any.
- Be a resident of Georgia.
- Be 62 of age or older at the time of registration.
 - * A driver's license or other comparable official documentation of age must be presented to the Office of the Registrar to determine eligibility.
- May enroll in classes on a space available basis without payment of tuition and mandatory fees.
- Meet all USG, VSU, and legislated degree requirements such as Major Area Exam and History and Constitution instruction or exams if degree seeking.
- The 62+ waiver covers all mandatory tuition/fees. Any additional fees such as application, lab, or material costs are the responsibility of the student.
