Lee M. Bennett Art Scholarship

All Art Majors who meet the qualifications listed below are encouraged to apply for the Bennett Art Scholarship.

The Lee M. Bennett Art Scholarship was established in 1997 in memory of Lee Medler Bennett (1915-1996), Professor of Art at VSU. Professor Bennett began her VSU career as a part time instructor in 1953 and retired in 1985 as a full Professor. She taught art history, drawing, painting, ceramics, printmaking and graphics. The purpose of the Lee Bennett Art Scholarship is to encourage quality students to pursue their study of Art at VSU. She would wish for each recipient a successful career in the field of art and that they share their love of art with others.

Amount:

\$1000.00 per semester for the fall and spring semesters. This award is subject to review by the Department of Art & Design Scholarship Committee each semester for renewal. The Bennett Scholarship is continuous (fall and spring semesters only) until graduation or until the student has completed 129 semester credit hours, whichever comes first. The student must continue to meet all the criteria outlined in the Lee M. Bennett Scholarship Fund Agreement.

The successful applicant must:

- be an Art major.
- have completed at least 14 credit hours of study and no more than 90 credit hours of study toward their art major at VSU or another institution.
- pursue at least 12 credit hours per semester and be enrolled in a minimum of one major curriculum class per semester
- maintain a 2.7 overall GPA, and a 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale in major course work.

Applicants must submit to the Scholarship Committee:

- a letter of application that states which scholarship/scholarships you wish to apply for and cites your current overall GPA and completed hours. This letter should include applicant's current mailing address, telephone number and student ID number. *Students who apply for multiple scholarships must state so in this letter of application.*
- a current unofficial transcript (transcript may be obtained from the student's access to Banner- there is no need to pay for an official transcript!)
- a portfolio containing (up to 2 images each), of five 5 of their best works. Digital portfolios will be accepted. Digital images must be in jpg format and must be good quality and accurately represent the work. Image files must be labeled: name_title.jpg
- a completed scholarship application form (obtained from the VSU Department of Art web site at <http://www.valdosta.edu/art/artscholarship>).

Entry Submissions:

All applications and support materials will be submitted digitally. All questions and submissions should be sent to the Scholarship Committee at artscholarships@valdosta.edu. Incomplete entries will not be reviewed.
